



MCC DAILY SCHEDULE FOR EARLY CHILDHOOD (3 YEARS – 6 YEARS)

*Toileting occurs individually. Children wash hands after toileting, coming in from outside, and before eating.

Time	Activity	Comments
8:00-8:50	Children arrive individually and are greeted warmly as they transition into the playground.	Parents sign in at the door. Breakfast is available for children to help themselves until 10:30 a.m. Children have an opportunity to enjoy the morning time outside, to help with gross motor development and assist in their getting their bodies ready to learn.
9:00-10:00	Open work time. The children choose work and activities and engage with materials individually, with friends, or have a presentation from a teacher. Older children have work folders as guidelines for curriculum areas to complete.	Materials are always available and include a varied assortment of practical life, gross motor activities, sensory experiences, manipulatives, language, reading and writing activities, math activities, geography, culture, books, building, art, etc.
10:00-10:20	Community Circle	Music, Movement, stories, calendar, presentations from head teacher
10:20-11:45	Work, activities and presentations	Continued as above
11:45-12:00	Community Circle	Music, Movement, stories, calendar, presentation from head teacher
12:00-12:30	Lunch is served family style, with children encouraged to independently use silverware and glasses.	Lunch that is supplied by the family is transferred to a plate. All leftovers are sent home to the parent. After finishing, the child carries his/her dish to the low sink and washes his/her hands
12:30-1:15	Outdoor activity	Children play outside on the playground, supervised by staff. In inclement weather, children may take a walk on the colonnade.
1:15-3:00	Nap and rest	Children sleep in low cots with sheets and lovies provided from home. Bedding is sent home to be washed weekly. Cots are thoroughly cleaned weekly. Cots are assigned and are not shared.
1:15-4:00	Enrichment Activities and snack	This is also a time for art and culture projects, group singing, yoga, listening to books on tape, listening to music, movement activities, and other afternoon activities to help keep the children engaged.
4:00- 5:00	Second Outdoor activity	Children play outside on the playground . In inclement weather, children may take a walk on the colonnade or ride bikes.
5:00-5:30	Teachers prepare remaining children for departure. Final dismissal is at 5:30. Community gathering	Parents collect belongings in the child's closet in the hallway, along with their Daily Sheet and any other messages in their mailbox, and sign their child out.
